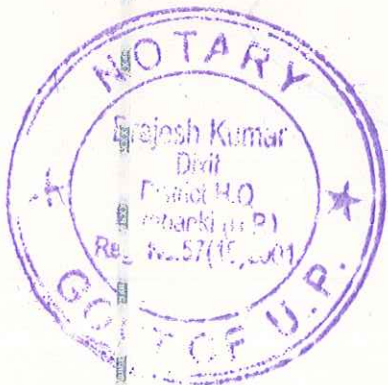

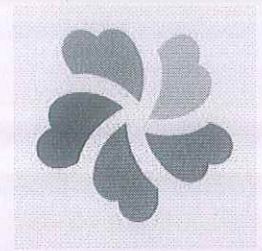

Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Socioaid Services and Development Foundation
And
Shri Ramswaroop Memorial University



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and executed at Lucknow on 21/05/2026

Between

Socioaid Services And Development Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "Socioaid Foundation"), a not-for-profit organization, registered under Section 8, of the Companies Act, 2013; working in the areas of public health, nutrition, climate action, mental health, skill & youth development, research and training, other social impact areas.

And

Shri Ramswaroop Memorial University (hereinafter referred to as "SRMU"), located at Lucknow Deva Road, Barabanki, Uttar Pradesh is a private university established by an act of state legislature of Uttar Pradesh.

Both Socioaid Foundation and SRMU shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as "the Parties".

Whereas both institutions desire to establish collaboration in the areas of skill development, FDPs, research, and management related trainings and high impact capacity building programs in relevant other domains as per need. This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) sets out the framework for the cooperative relationship between both the parties to enhance efficacy, outcome and quality of education; particularly in the discipline of public health, social work, management, and others as per the need.

PURPOSE

The Purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework to:

- Promote community-based development initiatives
- Strengthen public health, nutrition, and mental health awareness
- Facilitate student engagement, internships, and field exposure
- Support research, training, and capacity building
- Bridge academia and grassroots development practice

NOW therefore the two parties have agreed to cooperate as follows:

AREAS OF COLLABORATION

- i. Organizing workshops, seminars and conferences for students and faculties
- ii. Facilitative Support in Internship opportunities for the students of SRMU.
- iii. Organizing Faculty Development Programs (FDP).
- iv. Support students and faculties for exposure visits, and similar other field visits.
- v. Development of knowledge products, reports, and case studies

MANAGEMENT OF THE COLLABORATION

Each Institution on shall designate a coordinator to develop and coordinate the program activities. The coordinators will carry out jointly the various activities covered under the MOU.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Any intellectual output developed jointly shall be shared mutually. Publications, reports, or research outputs shall acknowledge both parties. Prior written consent shall be required before independent use of jointly developed material. Regarding authors' rights, only co-investigators and other staff that have contributed significantly to the study planning, fieldwork, data analysis and write-up, will be included as co-authors.

DURATION OF THE MEMORANDUM

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect from the date of execution and shall remain in force for a period of One (03) year.

IMPLEMENTATION

All laws, rules and regulations issued by all parties shall be strictly observed at all times.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

The parties shall use reasonable endeavors to amicably settle disputes arising out of or in connection with this Collaboration Agreement.

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be held responsible for failure to perform due to circumstances beyond control (natural disasters, government restrictions, etc.).

Either party shall promptly notify the other party, in writing, of any situation or event arising from circumstances beyond their control, which they could not have reasonably foreseen, and which makes the performance of all or part of the parties' obligations under this contract impossible.

Upon notification of the occurrence of such a situation or event, the performance of this collaboration shall be deemed to be postponed for a period of time equivalent to that caused by the Force Majeure and reasonable period and shall be allowed for re-mobilization to continue the performance of the collaboration.

REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

The Memorandum may be amended, revised or extended if both parties agree. Such amendments or revision shall be effective from the date of signature.

Amendments may be decided at any time and shall be made in writing upon mutual consent of the parties.

TERMINATION OF MEMORANDUM

The memorandum of Understanding may be terminated with immediate effect by mutual agreement between the parties or by either party giving the other not less than three (03) months' notice in writing.




