COVID-19 AND SOCIAL DISORDER

The faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences of Shri Ramswaroop Memorial University, organized a one-day Sociology webinar on Covid-19 and Social disorder on May 12, 2020 at 11:30A.M. The webinar witnessed the dialects of eminent sociologists like Prof. Shruti Tambe (Director, Euroculture, HoD Department of Sociology, Savitribai Phulu Pune University, Pune) Prof. Biswajit Ghosh (University of Burdwan), Prof. Rajesh Misra (Former HoD, Department of Sociology, University of Lucknow).

The speakers reflected on various societal problems that are emerging due to COVID-19. Prof. Tambe analysed the condition of the unorganized sector mainly labourers in the current scenario in context to the state and centre policies. Prof. Ghosh associated the ongoing social disorders with the delayed and faulty policies implemented by the government. Prof. Misra spoke about the several dimensions of social disorder (domestic violence, legitimation crisis, poverty etc.). These speakers reflected on various serious issues in the society and presented a deep sociological analysis of the same.
