About the Webinar

Last one decade, Indian education system has seen some major changes that are swift and far reaching. After the success of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Rashtriya Uchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) were launched to improve the educational access, enrolment and retention of students in the age group 14-24 years for school and higher education. The purpose of these two national level programmes is to ensure the access of secondary education to 75% of the total school going children in the age group of 14-18 years and that of 30% in the age group of 18-23 years for higher education. The growth at both the level of education is quite impressive not only in access, enrolment, retention but also in the attainment of different parameters of quality education. Further, Agenda for Sustainable Development (SDG)-2030 provide impetus to the steps taken by the Indian government for achieving the goals set aside by UN by 2030. New India is at the helm of a new decade. India has the largest human resource in terms of youth population. Educating them with knowledge, skill and training and transform them into power house of knowledge economy is not only a greatest challenge but also a greatest opportunity which New India needs to seize it. Therefore, structural reforms in education system in general and components in particular is the need of the hour. Draft of National Education Policy has already highlighted the major structural reforms that will be initiated in the field of education. Technology has to play a greater role not only in spreading education across the country but also help the education system to be more efficient, effective, robust and easily accessible. That's why Government of India in last several years recognizing its potential and reach initiated several Digital Initiatives in education field and results are slowly coming in.
