Also, please indicate whether an oral or poster presentation is preferred (due to limited time only few abstracts will be given opportunity for oral presentation). **It must be noted that the abstracts of only registered candidates will be considered for oral/poster presentation.**

All the submitted abstracts will be scrutinized by a reviewing committee and the participants will be intimated about the acceptance of their abstracts through e-mail. Selected abstracts will be sent for publication as full research paper in UGC approved journals.
