Process Flow for entering into IV Year and exiting from III Year under NEP Programmes:

- 1. As per the guidelines, III Year students enrolled in above programmes can only be promoted to IV year if they fulfill following conditions:
 - a) No 'F' Grade at the end of third year
 - b) Student should secure a minimum CGPA of 7.50

IMP: If any student fail to meet the above criteria, will be required to exit in the third (III) year only

- All the students of abovementioned programmes who have obtained 7.50 CGPA or more than till V semester are required to indicate their interest for pursuing their studies of IV Year in the attached format latest by MARCH 11, 2025.
- 3. If any student fail to meet the criteria laid down in clause 01 (a) after declaration of III Year result of mentioned programmes, he/she will be provided another opportunity to clear their backlogs in 'Special Summer Examination'.
- 4. After declaration of 'Special Summer Examination' result, interested students who will obtain 7.50 CGPA or more without any 'F' Grade, will be permitted to opt for pursuing their studies of IV Year for Degree with Hons or Degree with Research (as applicable).
- 5. Students enrolled in above-mentioned programmes who will complete their Four year Degree with Hons or Degree with Research will be eligible for enrollment in one Year Masters Programme instead of two years Masters Programme.
