
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EXAMINATION POLICY IN VIEW OF COVID 19 PANDEMIC

1. Introduction

In this phase of turbulence due to COVID 19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown, it was need of the hour to review and reinvent the existing teaching-learning methodology, evaluation policy etc. through innovative technology. For safeguarding the interests of students as various students belongs to different districts of UP, Bihar etc, the University constituted a committee to review the existing Examination Policy and Calendar in the wake of 'UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in View of COVID-19 Pandemic and Subsequent Lockdown' issue vide UGC letter no. F. 1- I / 2020 (SecY) 29th April, 2020.

As per clause 01, 02, 03 & 05 of UGC guidelines under the head of examination, the Universities were given freedom to conduct Final year/Pre Final Year examination in offline/online mode through MCQ/OMR based examinations, Open Book Examination, Open Choices, assignment/ presentation-based assessments etc. after making a comprehensive assessment of their level of preparedness, residential status of the students, status of COVID-19 pandemic spread in different region/state and other factors, observing the guidelines of "social distancing" and keeping in view the support system available and ensuring fair opportunity to all students.

In view of current situation of COVID 19 pandemic which does not seems to be normal, it would not be feasible to hold offline examination keeping non availability of hosteller students in campus due to lockdown, dimensions of social distancing, safety, and health concern of students. Needless to mention here that almost 100% students adapted online teaching learning process, joined google classes/zoom platform, actively participated in online teaching learning process and appeared in the online internal assessments of the University. In view of this, since the University students are equipped with internet facility for appearing in online examination, the University has adopted the online mode for assessment/examination.

As per the recommendations of constituted committee in the light of UGC guidelines, instructions issued by Uttar Pradesh Higher Education Department, subsequent brainstorming in meetings of examination committee and directions of higher authorities, Examination Policy has been laid down which shall be effective till the efficient control of pandemic. This policy is subject to change based upon the instructions and guidelines issued by the statutory bodies time to time.

2. Conduction of End Semester Theory Examination

After filling Online Examination Form, End Semester Examination for Final year students shall be held during **July 01-11, 2020** and for other than final year students, it shall be held during **July 16-31, 2020** as per Examination Schedule published by the Examination Cell.

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In view of COVID 19 pandemic, the End Semester Examination shall be conducted using online mode in this semester as per detailed mentioned in clause 2.1, 2.2, 2.3 & 2.4 regarding preparation and pattern of question paper, duration and shift of examinations, mode of conducting examinations, grading pattern etc.

2.1 Preparation and Pattern of Question Paper

End Semester online examination shall be conducted through Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). Faculty members shall formulate 150 MCQs alongwith solution for their respective subjects on the prescribed format shared by Pro-Chancellor Secretariat and out of them, 48 questions will be asked in the MCQ's based End Semester Examination after quality assurance by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans, HODs.

The question paper shall consist of 48 multiple choice questions. Entire paper shall be divided into 3 Sections i.e. A, B & C based upon the following:

Section A: Low Level: 30 Questions (30 X 1 marks=30 Marks)

Section B: Medium Level: 12 Questions (12 X 1.5 marks=18 Marks)

Section C: High Level: 6 Questions(6 X 2 marks= 12 Marks)

Total Marks: 48 Questions (60 Marks)

The detailed Question paper pattern is attached as Appendix A.

In addition to the above, the detailed question paper pattern for Bachelor of Agriculture {B.Sc. (Hons)_(Agriculture) is attached as an **Appendix B.**

Besides this, the detailed question paper pattern for Master of Laws Courses (LL.M all courses) is attached as an Appendix C.

On the basis of NCTE guidelines, the detailed question paper pattern for Bachelor of Education (B. Ed) is attached as an **Appendix D1** for half credit course and **Appendix D2** for full credit course.

On the basis of COA guidelines, the detailed question paper pattern for Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch), Diploma in Architecture (D. Arch) and Bachelor of Interior Design (BID) is attached as Appendix F.

Finalized Question Papers alongwith its solution shall be shared by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments with the Examination Cell for records after the conduction of End Semester Examination.

2.2 Duration and Shift of Examination

Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) based online examination shall be conducted for the maximum duration of two hours (2 hours) in two shifts as under:

First Shift: 10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon

Second Shift: 02:00 PM - 04:00 PM

2.3 Mode for conducting Examination

In order to conduct online examination successfully, it was prerequisite to utilize such platforms which can be effortlessly work on computer/laptop as well as on mobile phones.

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As per the Examination Schedule released by Examination Cell, Faculty members shall conduct the same through ERP or Google Platform which shall be proctored/recorded through G-Meet by the faculty members.

Since, the University is conducting MCQ based online test first time, it is prerequisite to familiarize the students regarding pattern of online assessment prior to Examination. In order to get students acquainted with this evaluation method, model paper/mock test on same pattern (Section A: 4 Questions, Section B: 4 Questions, Section C: 2 Questions) shall be conducted by the respective faculty members.

Every day after conduct of End Semester Examination, list of present and absent students shall be shared on a daily basis with the Examination Cell.

After conduction of the End Semester Examination, the soft copy of answer sheets with proper naming convention shall be submitted by the students which shall be further compiled in a Folder by subject Faculty (Department-wise) and shall be submitted by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments for records in the Examination Cell. Guidelines of naming convention shall be issued separately.

2.4 Grading Pattern in Examinations

As per our previous practice, relative grading shall be done and thus Faculty members are desired to generate and submit their MGPA to the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs.

3. Conduction of End Semester Practical Examination and Carryover Practical Examination

As per SES of various courses, most of the experimental labs are of 80:20 ratio representing 80 Marks for internal assessment and 20 Marks for external assessment. All the internal assessment of the practical (80 marks) shall be finalized by the Faculty members till May 31, 2020 as per already issued instructions.

All the external practical examination/non experimental labs/Project/Viva/Dissertation and other related examination shall be done **during June 08-15**, **2020** along with posting of internal and external marks in ERP consist of 100 marks. All the external assessment of practical (20 marks) and non experimental labs/Project/Viva/Dissertation (100 marks) shall be done by using any one of the following:

- (i) Online assessment through Google classroom/platform created for each lab and Viva-Voce may be taken using different platforms like Hangout, G Meet, Skype, Zoom, Cisco and WebEx etc.
- (ii) Conduction of MCQ based online quiz test containing at least 20 MCQs covering all the topics of practical's defined in the syllabus and the duration of the test will be 30 minutes at least.

For external practical examination, an 'Internal Examiners Committee' shall be constituted by the respective HODs/Deans/Principal/Director of the Department/Faculty/Institute duly approved by the Vice Chancellor one week prior to scheduling the practical examination.

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Based upon the statistics of online form submission of Carryover Examination, practical examinations for the Carryover cases of final year and passed-out batches shall only be conducted along with the Regular End Semester Practical Examination.

Separate schedule for practical examination will be issued by respective Department/Faculty/ Institute

For Non-Experimental Labs/Term Paper/Seminar etc, detailed guidelines already issued vide Inter Office Memo Ref. No. SRMU/Pro-VC/2019-20/IOM dated April 27, 2020 shall be effective.

4. Conduction of Carryover Theory Examination (For Final Year Students and Passed out Batches only)

In view of COVID 19, this year Carryover Examination shall only be conducted for final year students. In order to facilitate, progression of passed out batches and current batch (final year) students for higher studies/job/placement, Carryover Examination for all COP cases (odd and even both) of passed out batches and current batch (Final year only) shall be conducted during June 18-30, 2020. Based upon the statistics of Online Carryover Form submission, Examination Schedule shall be published later on.

In this session, only students of final year and passed out batches shall be eligible to fill the form. Carryover examination shall not be conducted in current session for students other than final year students. For students other than final year, decision regarding conduct of Carryover Examination will be taken later on.

4.1 Preparation and Pattern of Question Paper

Institute/Faculty wise list of Carryover subjects of Final Year students and Carryover Cases of previous passed out batches has been prepared by Examination Cell and circulated to concerned Institutes/Faculties/Departments.

Based upon the statistics of online form submission regarding Carryover papers, Examination Cell shall explore its repository and provide the question papers of previous End Semester Examination (in Soft copy)to faculty members, who shall change /modify the paper (by doubling the marks in each section or reducing no of parts to be attempted in all the three Sections A, B and C) in consultation with Directors, Principal, Deans, HODs for quality assurance as per the pattern provided by Examination Cell.

The question paper shall be divided into 3 sections i.e. A, B & C as mentioned below:

Section A: Remembering and Understanding: (10/5 parts with 2/4marks each = 20 Marks)

Section B: Understanding and Apply: (4 parts of 5 Marks each =20 Marks)

Section C: Apply and Analyzing: (2 parts of 10 Marks each =20 Marks)

Total Marks: 60 Marks

The detailed Question paper pattern is attached as Appendix-E

After conduction and evaluation of the Carryover Examination, the soft copy of answer sheets (in pdf) with proper naming convention shall be submitted by the students which shall be further compiled in a Folder by subject Faculty (Institute/Faculty/Departmentwise) and shall be submitted by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of

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Institutes/Faculties/Departments for records in the Examination Cell. Guidelines of naming convention shall be issued separately.

4.2 Duration and Shift of Examination

Open Book based online examination shall be conducted by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departmentsfor the maximum duration of two hours (02 hours) in two shifts as under:

First Shift:

10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon

Second Shift: 02:00 PM - 04:00 PM

4.3 Mode for conducting Examinations

In order to conduct online examination successfully, it was prerequisite to utilize such platforms which can be effortlessly work on computer/laptop as well as on mobile phones. As per the Examination Schedule released by Examination Cell, the Faculty members shall conduct the Open Book Examination through uploading the Word doc in Google Platform which shall be proctored/recorded through G-Meet by the faculty members.

Every day after conduct of carryover papers, list of present and absent students shall be shared on a daily basis with the Examination Cell for class creation and class enrollment.

After conduction of the Carryover Examination, the answer sheets shall also be submitted in the Examination Cell by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments for records.

4.4 Grading Pattern in Examination

As per our previous practice, relative grading shall be done in case of Carryover Examination.

IMPORTANT NOTE: In case of transferred students, exam shall be conducted alongwith Carryover Exam on the similar pattern after filling the form in the Examination Cell for which respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments shall disseminate their respective students.

5. Conduction of Special Summer Examination/Improvement Examination (For Final Year Students & Passed out Batches only)

Based upon the result declaration regarding End Semester Examination of final year and Carryover Examination of final year and passed out batches during third week of July, Online Form for Special Summer Examination shall be filled during fourth week of July by those students of final year and passed out batches who all are having 'F' or 'P' or 'C' grades in Theory & Practical subjects of the corresponding/same year to improve their grades in the respective subjects at the end of even semester of each academic session.

Besides this, Online Form for Special Summer Examination shall be filled by those students of final year or passed out batches also who were previously absent or were unable to appear due to technical reasons as per clause 06 of UGC guidelines under the head of examination.

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Special Summer Examination shall be conducted ONLY for Final Year and Carryover Cases of passed out batches in the month of August through online/offline mode as per the prevailing circumstances.

5.1 Preparation and Pattern of Question Paper

Based upon the statistics of online form submission by the students regarding Special Summer Examination/Improvement Examination, list of candidates shall be prepared by the Exam Cell. Prior to conduct of special summer examination, Exam Cell shall provide the question papers of previous End Semester Examination (in Soft copy) to the faculty members, who shall change /modify the paper (by doubling the marks in each section or reducing no of parts to be attempted in all the three Sections A, B and C) in consultation with Directors, Principal, Deans, IIODs for quality assurance as per the pattern provided by Examination Cell.

The question paper shall be divided into 3 sections i.e. A, B & C as mentioned below:

Section A: Remembering and Understanding (10/5 parts with 2/4marks each = 20 Marks)

Section B: Understanding and Apply: (4 parts of 5 marks each=20 Marks)

Section C: Apply and Analyzing: (2 parts of 10 marks each =20 Marks)

Total Marks: 60 Marks

The detailed Question paper pattern is attached as Appendix E.

After conduction and evaluation of the Special Summer Examination/Improvement Examination, the soft copy of answer sheets (in pdf) with proper naming convention shall be submitted by the students which shall be further compiled in a Folder by subject Faculty (Institute/Faculty/Department-wise) and shall be submitted by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments for records in the Examination Cell. Guidelines of naming convention shall be issued separately.

5.2 Duration and Shift of Examination

Open Book based online examination shall be conducted by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments for the maximum duration of **two hours (02 hours)** in two shifts as under:

First Shift: 10:00 AM - 12:00 Noon

Second Shift: 02:00 PM - 04:00 PM

5.3 Mode for conducting Examinations

In order to conduct online examination successfully, it was prerequisite to utilize such platforms which can be effortlessly work on computer/laptop as well as on mobile phones. As per the Examination Schedule released by Examination Cell, the Faculty members shall conduct the Open Book Examination through uploading the Word doc in Google Platform which shall be proctored/recorded through G-Meet by the faculty members.

Every day after conduct of special summer/improvement papers, list of present and absent students shall be shared on daily basis with the Examination Cell for class creation and class enrollment.

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After conduction of the Special Summer/Improvement Examination, the answer sheets shall also be submitted in the Examination Cell by the respective Directors, Principal, Deans and HODs of Institutes/Faculties/Departments for records.

5.4 Grading Pattern in Examination

As per our previous practice, relative grading shall be done in case of Special Summer/Improvement Examination.

6. Award of Degree to Final Year Students

Based upon the student performance during Online End Semester Examination and internal assessment, grades shall be awarded to all the final year students. With the aim to provide one more opportunity to all the final year students, another opportunity as Special Summer Examination/Improvement Examination shall be provided to all final year students only in this academic session, who all are having 'F' or 'P' or 'C' grades in Theory & Practical subjects to improve their grades in the respective subjects.

After End Semester Examination and Special Summer Examination, all the students of the University pursuing a programme or course shall be eligible to be awarded the prescribed degree, if;

- (a) he/she has NO 'F' Grades.
- (b) he/she should 'Qualify' all the Non-Credit (NC) subjects during the study period.

Note: No divisions are awarded in Grading System. Performance is estimated from the CGPA score.

If any student of final year or passed out batches secure 'F' Grade in any subject/subjects after both the examinations, he/she shall be treated as a Carryover Case. Therefore, he/she shall get another opportunity to clear his/her 'F' grade and pass the course in the next academic session only.

7. Promotion Policy for other than Final Year Students

Based upon the student performance during Online End Semester Examination and internal assessment, grades shall be awarded to all the students. In view of prevailing COVID 19 pandemic, the University shall promote all the students (other than final year) to next semester of ensuing academic session irrespective of their number of credits.

Carry over examination and Special summer examination shall not be conducted for other than Final year students.

8. Conduction of Improvement/Carryover Examination for other than Final Year

Improvement/Carryover examination of those students may be conducted in the month of December 2020/January 2021 for **odd and even semester subjects** together in order to avoid loss of any student for the upcoming placement activities.

In view of COVID 19 pandemic, another opportunity as Improvement/Carryover Examination shall be provided to <u>all other than final year students only for this semester</u>, who all are unable to appear in the online examination conducted during July 16-31, 2020 or having 'F' or

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'P' or 'C' grades in Theory & Practical subjects to improve their grades in the respective subjects with the aim to provide one more opportunity to other than final year students.
