Society considers us as creators of new knowledge and new ideas and we also care for all the societal needs including placements, community engagements, welfare and cultural awareness exercises.



In continuation with above the department is trying to improve his performance day-by-day to keep the University running smoothly and efficiently.

Director Student Welfare

a) **Proctorial Board** through Chief Proctor — to look after the general discipline and hence, academic ambience of the University.

Report: No incidents of Ragging was reported to the Portal or on personal basis hence, no action of Anti Ragging Committee.

7 incidences of indiscipline wherein 18 students were suspended from University and one

student amongst 18 student was a regular defaulter and was expelled from the University on 23rd December, 2021. In a serious case of group fight near University Main Gate on 7th May, 2022, 4 students were suspended on 9th May, 2022 as the local police lodged a case against them and none of them appeared in the end semester examination.

b) Hostels (Boys & Girls) through Chief Warden – to look after the comfort of the resident students which includes fooding, lodging and general health and hygiene along with general discipline within Hostel premise.

Report: 1 incidence of indiscipline with 1 student expelled from the hostel.

'Hum Sab Ke Andar Kalakar' – A workshop is organized on 29th September, 2021 with Mr. Vivek Shukla from Doordarshan Kendra Lucknow, Mr. Puneeta Awasthy from All India Radio, Lucknow more than 200 students participated in the workshop.

c) Student Welfare Fund through Finance Officer – to look after the financial help of genuinely needy student through a committee having student representatives.

Report: 35 Beneficiaries Rs. 5,19,000/-

d) Student Mentorship Program through Faculty Mentor with concern Deans – to improve the assigned a set of students' overall performance by looking after their learning, counseling them to maximize their potential and suggesting them to develop life skills.

Report: Total Mentee – 4005, Mentors – 216, hence Av. Mentee-Mentor ratio be 18.54

e) University Student Senate – interface between students in mass and authority of university to raise academic and administrative issues related to students.

Announcement of dates of Nomination and Election of Class Representative (CRs), Institute Representative (IRs), Office Bearers and Nominated Members on 27th September, 2021 and 26th October, 2021 respectively.

The election for University Student Senate have been successfully conducted on 30th October, 2021 with 40 IRs, 4 Office Bearers on 11th November, 2021 and 10 Nominated Members on 16th November, 2021.

Badge Giving and Oath Taking Ceremony was held on 25th November, 2021 with Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Pro Vice Chancellor and Registrar.

Meetings with IRs on 13th December, 2021 to finalize the agenda points for the meeting with University Authorities.

Meeting with IRs and University Authorities headed by Vice Chancellor on 26th March, 2022 with 7 agenda points from Senate side and 2 Addional Points was handled by Convener and Secretary of USS in association with DSW.

Concluding Meeting with Senate Members was held on 4th July, 2022 wherein Action Taken Report was presented by Dy. Reg. Acad. and then Certificates were distributed amongst Senate Members by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor while Director-Student welfare proposed the vote of thanks.

f) Student Grievance Redressal Committee: In the current academic session, a total of 1055 grievances were raised by the students from the various departments of the University. Among those maximum grievances (765) were raised for the Registrar Office related to Roll No. generation, term activation etc. Followed by Accounts Office where 221 grievances related to Hostel Fee/ Caution Money Refund, Generation of Fee receipt etc.

were registered. A combined total of 52 grievances were raised against the ERP Cell and the Examination Cell with regards to the enrollment, subject tagging, issuance of degree and marksheet etc. Remedial actions were taken against all and were resolved in 2 to 3 working days.



Department of Extensions/Community services has always felt pride for bringing about the much-needed change in the society. As a part of this wonderful initiative time and again various activities are organized as well. Some of these successfully conducted activities are as mentioned below:

Initiatives

- **PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL YOJANA**: In implementation of this scheme a workshop was organized by Department of extension/community services and Business Consultancy Club along with **Jute for Life**, following which an MoU was signed with organization as well.
- <u>HAR GHAR TIRANGA</u>: As government of India issued Har GharTiranga drive, SRMU in no time also joint the wonderful initiative. As a part of this mission flags were distributed in nearby villages along with beautiful display of street play and other activities.
- <u>AAZADI KA AMRUT MAHOTSAV</u>: To celebrate and commemorate 75 years of Independence, the initiative of Aazadi ka Amrut Mahotsav was launched by the Indian government. As a result, various events were conducted by the clubs both in online and offline mode.
- <u>1090 AWARNESS DRIVE</u>:-All the above programmes were organized with the aim of providing awareness to the people of the university as well as nearby village area. Simultaneously the department is facilitating in providing free health checkups, diet plans but most importantly making the people aware about Hygiene, Pre-marriage Counseling etc. and thus discharging its obligation to the community.
- Several self-help groups, NGOs and local administration have joined hands to ensure that masks which is a very essential means of protection from the infection must reach everyone in the country.
- Likewise, session was organized for NSS/NCC/1090 AND WOMENS OF NEARBY ADOPTED VILLAGES, Event ON PRE-POST MENOPOUSE and SESSION ON REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH
- The full day event was addressed by Dr. Deepa Kapoor (Sr. Gynecologist, SGPGI). She emphasized to educate girls and women with a holistic and engaging curriculum. Instead of just focusing on menstrual hygiene, it should start by creating an understanding of the menstruation process and its role in reproduction. Girls and women should be made to understand that menstruation is a normal biological process that brings in both physical and emotional changes; there should be no shame attached to it.

• Hygiene is important, but girls need to understand what is happening in their bodies. Menstruation is a natural process but it is rarely talked about because of cultural taboos. Menstrual hygiene – how to manage menstruation safely and with dignity – has also been largely neglected by the water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) sector and others focusing on reproductive health and education. As a result, the menstrual hygiene challenges faced by women and girls are made even more difficult, and millions continue to be denied their rights to WASH, health, education, and dignity and gender equity. The sessions in this guide explores the key issues and components of menstrual hygiene management (MHM).

National Cadet Corps (NCC)



It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization, which recruits cadets from High Schools, Colleges and Universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.

The SRMU, for the welfare of the students intended to establish the NCC Senior Wings for girls in the University. The requisite application/ expression of interest was sent to Commanding Officer, 20 UP Girl's Battalion, Lucknow on 04.04.14. A team of NCC carried out physical inspection in the month of June and the consent of 55 Girls cadets from the Commanding Officer was received on **20th June 2014.** Which is extend to 65 on 26.09.2019.

The SRMU, for the welfare of the students intended to establish the NCC Senior Division for boys in the University. The requisite application/ expression of interest was sent to Commanding Officer, 63 UP Battalion, Lucknow. A team of NCC carried out physical inspection in the month of June and the consent of 80 Boys cadets from the Commanding Officer was received on **31th Oct 2020.**

In every year in the month of August a team of NCC came in the University for examination and selection procedure for first year. The University organizes regular parade on every Wednesday between 2:00pm to 4:00pm. It is compulsory to attend 40 parades per year each cadet. An Army Instructor comes every Wednesday from 20 UP Girl's Battalion, Lucknow to train the cadets. The instructor takes practical as well as theory class (environmental studies, First aid, Self defence, history of NCC etc.).

The University organizes regular parade on every Saturday between 12:00pm to 4:30pm. It is compulsory to attend 40 parades per year each cadet. An Army Instructor comes every Wednesday from 20 UP Girl's Battalion or 63 UP BN, Lucknow to train the cadets. The instructor takes practical and ANOtakestheory class (like Leadership, Personality Development, Environmental Studies, First aid, Self defence, history of NCC etc.). Other then regular parade, cadets are required to attend atleast 3 camps to complete the course. Yoga day special camp is compulsory for all cadets which is not included in the above-mentioned camps. While in the 1st year only training is imparted, in the 2nd year the cadets go for 'B' certificate exam including theory as well as practical exam. In the 3rd year they go for 'C' certificate exam where cadets have to give theory as well as practical exam again to pass. Other than parade, theory classes, shooting, and camp cadets also take part in following activities:
